As an initial participant in STEP2, EBA's Pan-European Automated Clearing House initiative, Société Générale has been one of the first banks to offer mass payments in euro throughout the European Union.

Based on these new developments, Société Générale has refurbished its heralded WebClear interactive service to client banks and SIBOS visitors are invited to Société Générale's booth (4109) for a demonstration of its enhanced facilities, including the new SWIFTNet Cash Reporting service.
